Without volunteers serving at all three of our locations we would be unable to provide the services we currently provide to our clients, which is why we always need more volunteers. As our ministry grows, our need for volunteers grows as well.

We have two pregnancy centers located at 101 W Market and 140 W Market and our life skills and education facility-Necole's Place--located at 706 E Chestnut Street. We currently have about 70 active volunteers and we always need more people to help out. From 2009 to 2010 we experienced an increase in new client cases of 26% at our pregnancy centers and an increase in the average number of women served at Necole's Place of 36%.

With this continued growth our need for volunteer help is also increasing. There are a number of ways to get involved as a volunteer at AWC and Necole's Place.
